Description of Award

The award to be presented shall include a plaque (or similar item) recognizing the winner and an announcement at the annual meeting in November in Wilmington, North Carolina. All award winners will also be recognized through announcements, including recognition on the NCBA Bankruptcy Section Blog.

Eligibility for Award

Individual Award: North Carolina Bar Association member in good standing and Bankruptcy Section member in good standing.

Presentation of Awards

The Outstanding Achievement Pro Bono Award will be presented at the Bankruptcy Section's Annual Meeting on Friday, November 22, 2019 in Wilmington, NC.
